OUR PURPOSE

To support children's perseverance in school by accompanying them in the development of their academic motivation, their sense of organization, their social skills and their selfesteem.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

With your agreement, the child is enrolled 2 to 4 days per week for a period of

school tutoring. This study

period takes place at lunch

depending on the school.

time or after school,

Your child is referred by his/ her teacher or a member of the school team.

Groups of 4 to 8 children are formed according to the children's grade level. An intervenor is responsible for each group.

While attending the workshops, your child starts his homework and lessons and carries out educational activities aimed at motivating him and showing him that learning can be fun: creative projects, reading activities, robotics workshops and other digital activities to support learning!




RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE REGISTERED CHILD

OUR PURPOSE

Accompany you in your academic support role and provide support for your child to stay in school.

WHY DO WE COME TO YOUR HOME?

We want to support your child's school perseverance by working mainly on 4 elements:

ACADEMIC MOTIVATION (learning for fun

(learning for fun, doing digital activities, etc.) WORK
ORGANIZATION
(using the agenda, establishing a routine, etc.)

SOCIAL SKILLS

(working quietly, listening to instructions, etc.)

SELF-ESTEEM

(value the child's strengths, let them experience small successes, etc.)



HOW DOES IT WORK?



A Je Passe Partout intervenor comes to work with you and your child at home. Work objectives are developed together, parent, child and intervenor.

These goals are worked on through homework, lessons, digital tools, and educational activities to get the child excited about learning and support their perseverance.



EVERY WEEK, WE LEARN WHILE HAVING FUN!



- Once a week, at a time determined by the coordinator
- > 60 to 75 minutes per session
- The child is responsible for bringing his/her own school supplies
- The parent is responsible for making themselves available to participate in the workshop

IT'S A TEAM EFFORT. WE COUNT ON YOUR INVOLVEMENT!
